She waited until the service was over and, when only a few remained chatting within the church building, she sought to be helped in giving her life to Jesus (with her baby nestled on her back, sleeping soundly). In the quiet and stillness of the building, Gary and Diana were guided by our Lord, helping this woman give her life to Him. In sharp contrast to the hushed stillness, Heaven was rejoicing and the overflow of their joy spilled over into our hearts!

Gary had been led to speak mainly to God’s children during the service, but we are aware that God’s Holy Spirit has been working in the hearts of individuals and families in the area, and we rejoice that this is His work, and that He is still working. We yearn to see an even greater outpouring of His Holy Spirit and that many men, women and children will surrender their all to Him.

We have, at present, four girls staying at the Mission, and during the month had another girl come with a neighbouring chief also seeking help. Some of their stories are tragic and some heart-breaking. Metaphorically, they have tasted, some repeatedly, very bitter herbs and endured the nasty, sour aftertaste,



lingering long after its initial consumption, sickening body, mind and soul. It is our prayer that they will come to know in a real, deep manner our Lord and know His complete healing touch and His comfort, consolation and encouragement.

One girl’s situation involves a court case. To watch a stream of tears flow quietly down such a dear child’s face and sense that within, there is a medley of emotions, turmoil and tumult, is heart-wrenching. But our hearts are comforted as we commit her to One who can completely heal the broken-hearted and is the God of all comfort.

Prayer Points

- Pray that God’s Holy Spirit will continue to move mightily in the hearts and lives of the people within Olkinyei. Remember the woman who has given her life to Jesus, as she will undoubtedly face many trials and hardships. Pray that she will know our Beloved so very near, and will choose to continue walking with Him, putting on the whole armour of God.
- Pray too for the children who are seeking help at the Mission, that they will know the God of all comfort and have His peace in their hearts; and for us, that God will grant us His wisdom for each and every situation that arises, for His glory.
- Remember too our children as we are apart from one another. May our Lord be so very near to them, leading and guiding them.
